The National Service Scheme (NSS) is a government sponsored public service program in India that involves students in community service. The program's goals include:

1. **Developing Students:** The NSS aims to develop students' personalities and character through community service.
2. **Improving Quality:** The NSS aims to improve the quality of educated manpower.
3. **Building Connections:** The NSS aims to develop healthy connections between students and teachers and to establish a constructive link between the campus and the community.

The NSS was launched in 1969, the centenary year of “**Mahatma Gandhi**”. The NSS is a central sector scheme of the ministry of youth affairs and sports of the government of India.

The NSS unit of SJCIT was started in the year 2002 with the blessings of his Divine Soul Padmabhushana Sri Sri Sri Dr. Balagangadharanatha Maha Swamiji, the Founder President of Sri Adichunchanagiri Mutt.
